

# MOTHERS OF MULTIPLES CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT SALE RULES March 20, 2010

**Rules:** Please comply with the rules or you will have your sale buying and selling privileges suspended for 1 year

- If you are selling clothes you **MUST** bring a clothing rack. They are available at A to Z and SunRentals. You will **not** be reimbursed for rack rental or purchase. **Please try to make arrangements to set up Friday night if you are selling.**
- Sellers will be asked to **Sign In** when they first enter the gym. You will sign the rules, choose a job for Saturday and check-in your clothing rack. **You MUST be a PAID DUES member to sell. NO dues accepted at the sale.**
- Items must be priced and on hangers **PRIOR** to arrival. There will be **NO** pricing or hanging at the sale.
- **TAGS & PRICING — USE MASKING TAPE ONLY.** Tags should be **no longer than 3” or wider than 1”**. All tags must have **seller #, price and size** of item. **PLEASE** fold one end of the tape for easier removal and to speed the checkout process. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE PRICED IN 25-CENT INCREMENTS!**
- Please secure loose accessories in sandwich baggies. When tagging plastic bags or groups of items **place tag over another piece of tape** so it can easily be removed.
- **CLOTHING** Sell only **CLEAN, MENDED** children’s & maternity clothing, shoes, books, toys, bedding. Clothing will be placed on racks/tables organized by size. Please sell **seasonal clothing only** due to limited space. Swimsuits will be allowed year-round. Hanging items are more easily seen and usually sell better. Twin items tend to sell better if separated. Be sure your toys are in working order. Do not hide stains with price tags. If your clothing is in “play” condition, price accordingly. **Remember, you are selling to friends.**
- **NO CRAFT ITEMS ALLOWED**
- **LARGE ITEMS OR EQUIPMENT** An area will be designated for large items. Colored zip-ties will be placed on all large equipment for sale to help with security. If you are buying a large item, a holding area will be provided to hold the item(s) until you are ready to checkout. Please make sure your held items are marked w/ your name. **All items held under your name are considered sold.**
- Remember— you may **not** pick up items and carry them with you or reserve items in the holding area and then decide not to purchase them. This is clearly unfair to the seller. **It is your responsibility to inform your guest of these rules.**
- There will be no selling, shopping, pulling or bundling of items prior to the Liaison’s announcement to begin Member Shopping.
- Only Member **Sellers** will be allowed to shop Friday night. This is intended to be an incentive to get people setup Friday night. All members may shop Saturday morning during Member Shopping.
- **Please remember that if you sell you MUST stay at the sale the entire time and help work. MEMBERS CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED AT THE SALE**
- **NO BARTERING or NEGOTIATING** — If other members or customers try to negotiate a price, politely inform them that no bartering is allowed. **NO** tags will be taken at the checkout if the price has been changed. If you decide to reduce a price during the sale for your own reasons, a new tag must be made. Please let the Cashiers remove the tags at the time of purchase. (This prevents items being sold at the wrong price.)
- Please mark all items with your seller # if you’d like them returned to you (boxes, crates, racks, hangers, etc).
- Donation/Charity Table — a table will be provided for clothing and other items that you wish to donate after the sale. You **must** remove your tags before placing items on this table.
- Remember to be a good neighbor. Please return items to their proper tables & racks. Help keep all tables & racks tidy.
- **Fees** — 6% of your total sales  
**Hangers:** Check with Old Navy or Target, TJ Maxx, Wal-Mart Etc., they will sometimes save hangers for MOTS if you call ahead and reserve a pickup date. That saves on your hangers and they can go with the garments
